1.1 Product Introduction

The USB 3.1 Type-C Pocket Hub features four USB 3.0 ports for use with a MacBook or Pixel, extending functionality for connecting other devices.

1.2 Features

- 4-Port Hub with the latest USB 3.1 (Type C) connector
- Supports simultaneous operation of multiple USB 3.0, USB 2.0 and USB 1.1 devices
- Up to 5Gbps data transfer rate
- Hot-swapping feature allows you to connect/disconnect devices without powering down the system
- No device drivers required for Hub installation
- LED to indicate Hub power

Chapter 2: Getting Started

2.1 Hardware Installation

- Upon powering up your computer, the USB 3.1 Type-C Pocket Hub will be recognized by the computer's operating system.
